

From the runway to your home, a fashioned-inspired suite flaunts bold colours By Lisa Van de Ven

Fashion serves as inspiration in the model suite for Peter Street Condominiums. Specifically, the sartorial works of designers such as Kate Spade and Paul Smith, whose bright, colourful creations helped spur the designers' vision for the unit, which features a neutral base broken up by splashes of vivid hues. "We've used the fashion element in a very contained way," says the suite's interior designer, Elaine Cecconi of Cecconi Simone. "We've used it selectively, just to add a little colour, a little punch, a little whimsy and a little lightheartedness." The result, Ms. Cecconi says, is a suite an urban hipster would feel at home in. The two-bedroom, 610-square-foot unit begins with a monochromatic light grey base that's used for the floors, cabinetry and countertops. To that the design team added the splashes of vibrant colour — orange, yellow, blue and green — as well as stripe patterns that help create personality and pizzazz. "There's a relaxed attitude about the space," says the designer. "It's not intimidating." Suites at Peter Street Condominiums, by CentreCourt Developments, range in size from 303 to 772 sq. ft. and in price from the mid \$200,000s to the \$500,000s. "We didn't only want to limit the colour to the backsplash — we wanted to have a little nod to it in other aspects of the kitchen," says Ms. Cecconi.

> "We didn't want to use the colour ubiquitously, we just wanted to have little punches of it," says Ms. Cecconi. This end table from West Elm provides that perfect punch. If it were much bigger, she says, it would be too much. "It almost looks like a chess piece, which is great,"

she adds.

Here's a backsplash that ate the vivid striped effect, the design team applied a customdesigned adhesive vinyl to glass. The colour, and drama, sets the tone for the entire suite.

Along with the glass coffee table, this Satyr lounge chair from Avenue Road acts as a floating element in the room. Its open design doesn't go all the way to the floor, keeping the sightlines open. "When furniture comes to the floor it becomes very blocky and your space fills up visually, the designer says.
